*Due to the ongoing impact and ever changing nature of the COVID-19 virus, Gymnastics Australia may not be able to deliver a full Australian Gymnastics Championships program in 2021 as planned. All decisions will be made based on credible evidence and in the best interest of the health of all involved. Final decisions on event delivery and operations will be in line with both Federal and State guidelines and restrictions. All events will be delivered in line with Gymnastics Australia's COVID Safe Plan.*

## Competition Rules & Regulations

The 2021 Australian Gymnastics Championships will be conducted under the 2021 Technical Regulations and FIG Code of Points 2017 - 2021 for the respective GymSports. These documents are currently available on the Gymnastics Australia website.

## Competition Entry Fees

### Definitive Entries

Definitive Entries: \$245 (per individual, per GymSport)

Extra Division: \$60 (per individual, per GymSport)

Extra Divisions include the following;

- Rhythmic Gymnastics Individual & Group
- Trampoline Gymnastics National & International Stream
- Aerobic Gymnastics & AeroDance

Please note: TRP Sync will not be competed at the 2021 event.

### Additional Fees

- Late Entry Fee: \$300 plus the total entry fee per athlete entered into the event after the definitive entry cut-off date
- Late / Additional Official Entry Fee: \$150 This applies to all team officials who are submitted into the event after the definitive entry cut-off date
- Late music or music changes after the due date: \$50 per piece of music

## Definitive Entries

Definitive entries for the Australian Gymnastics Championships are now open and are due by Tuesday 13 April 2021. GA will send invoices to all STA's the week of the 19<sup>th</sup> April.

All definitive entries must be submitted in accordance with the standard GA processes, National Events Entry Policy and relevant Technical Regulations Part B. Please refer to the definitive entry user guide for further information.

## Opening Ceremony

An opening ceremony will take place on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May at 5:45pm. STA's are asked to please nominate a flag bearer for this. Flag bearers will be required to be at the venue by no later than 5:15pm.

All music must be submitted, in the correct format, but the due date. Music submission for this year's event will be done via DropBox. GA will set up a Master folder and invite each STA to the relevant folders. Please let Renata know if you would like additional individuals added.

After the 15<sup>th</sup> April, no music changes within the dropbox can occur and all individual will be given 'view' access only. If a piece of music needs to be changed it **MUST** be emailed through and the music change fee will apply.

## SIA Testing

States are reminded that any athletes attending the Australian Gymnastics Championships can be tested by SIA, regardless of whether they are competing in the Elite/Age Group stream of the National Levels stream. Gymnastics Australia is expecting that testing will be particularly prevalent in an Olympic year at all levels of our championships.

As such we are asking States to ensure that all team members are aware and understand the SIA testing process and their obligations. This can be achieved through either a face-to-face session or the SIA online level 1 module. It is recommended that all state team members complete one of the above training methods ahead of the Australian Gymnastics Championships.

If athletes on your team take regular medication, then we recommend they view the SIA website or call the hotline to check their medication is ok for consumption and if they require to take any action such as completing the TUE process.



## Member Protection & Child Safety Policy

Gymnastics Australia has solidified its position as a leader in child safety with the launch of a new stand-alone Child Safe Policy alongside a comprehensively reviewed and updated Member Protection Policy.
