

FIELD OF PLAY ACCESS

RG, AER & ACR Athletes

- Access to the Field of Play is via Entrance C
- All athletes will warm up in Hall 2, then make their way to the competition hall ahead of their routine
- Floor Managers will be on hand to assist with athlete movements
- As athletes will be crossing the foyer to reach the competition area, a coach must accompany the athlete and chaperone them

RG, AER & ACR Coaches

 Coaches may watch their athlete's routine from a designated viewing area located at the Field of Play entrance

RG Judges

- Access to the Field of Play is via the Trade Hall, far left corner
- Access via Entrance C is not permitted, except in emergencies

AER & ACR Judges

- Access is via Entrance C
- Judges must be seated at their tables no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the competition session
- Due to the shared access point, judges may only enter via Entrance C at scheduled times (e.g., mid-session breaks), unless in an emergency

MAG, WAG & TRP Athletes, Coaches & Judges

- Access is via the Trade Hall, far left corner
- Access via Entrance C is not permitted, except in emergencies

General Reminder

- Please do not jump over or break the Field of Play perimeter fencing to gain access under any circumstances
- All individuals must use the designated access points as outlined above

TRAINING HALL

RG

The training hall for RG is located in Hall 2 and will be a shared space with the RG warm up area. As such, athletes need to be mindful of the other athletes around them preparing for competition.

Athletes accessing the training hall space may only utilise the blue strip matting. The FIG RG floor is for competition warm up only. Athletes are not permitted to use this space for training.

MAG & WAG

MAG & WAG will have separate training spaces in Hall 2 as per previous years.

A speak will be provided for WAG which can be utilised for Floor routines.

While playing background music is allowed, we ask that music is played at an appropriate volume and that individuals are mindful of others in the space. The speaker provided by GA may only be used to play routine music.

ATHLETE WITHDRAWALS

Should an athlete need to be withdrawn from the competition, please complete the form below as soon as possible so all necessary adjustments can be made.

Refund applications must be submitted by each State/Territory Association and will be processed in line with the Event Refund Policy. Refunds will be paid directly to the relevant STA, and the refund form will be provided to all STAs following the conclusion of the event. To be eligible for a refund, a valid medical certificate must be submitted. In accordance with the policy, the refundable amount will be the entry fee minus a 20% administration fee.

All judges are asked to be in attendance for each session 1hr prior to the official session start time for roll call and any last minute instructions. If there are any clashes a judge has with other event responsibilities preventing them being in attendance 1hr prior to the start time, they need to communicate this directly to Rohan Kennedy (NJC).

Once judging panels are distributed, judges need to review and communicate any issues with their State Judging coordinator or delegated judge who will then need to communicate any adjustment with Rohan Kennedy (NJC). A reminder States are required to supply a minimum number of judges for each session. This can be found in the 2025 MAG Technical Regulations.

The official MAG Championship briefing will take place online on the evening of Tuesday 1st July at approximately 8pm. The meeting link will be communicated with State Teams to share with team judges the week prior. For the 1st time, state team coaches are invited to attend the briefing and submit questions via the chat feature which will be collated and addressed prior to the Championships commencing.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL EDUCATION SESSION

In 2025, GA will once again be hosting an Emergency Medical Education Session specific to gymnastics. The session will take place on Thursday 10th July and will run from approximately 9am - 4pm.

The day will be designed specifically for healthcare practitioners, targeting the physiotherapists and other healthcare practitioners supporting the state and territory teams at the event. The GA event doctors will also be in attendance.

There is no cost associated with attending this session however we ask that only those medical personal accredited for the 2025 event attend.

SAFER SPORT COURSE REQUIREMENTS

As in previous years Gymnastics Australia requires members of our community to complete the following educational requirements relevant to their role ahead of the start of the competition.

Gymnastics Australia requires officials to provide evidence of the following items prior to collecting their accreditation;

- A valid Working With Children Check (or equivalent)
- Photo ID

This year, Gymnastics Australia will verify the relevant education course competition prior to officials' arrival at the event, to ensure a smooth process for all at the accreditation center. Officials need to have their SIA and GA certificates easily accessible if required.
