Provisional Entries

Provision Entries for all Gymsports will close on Tuesday 21 April 2026.

Definitive Entries

- Definitive entries for MAG, WAG & TRP are due Tuesday 26 May 2026
- Definitive entries for RG, AER & ACR are due Tuesday 2 June 2026

Additional information around the entry process for the event will be shared in the coming weeks.

Entry Fee

\$330 inc GST per athlete, per Gymsport

Any fees due payable to Gymnastics Australia will be issued to you via an invoice from a third-party platform. This may attract additional fees associated with the payment method chosen. Event Rules and Regulations

The 2026 Australian Gymnastics Championships will be conducted under the 2026 Technical Regulations and World Gymnastics Code of Points 2025 - 2028 for the respective Gymsports.

These documents are currently available on the Gymnastics Australia website and World Gymnastics website respectively.

Provisional Entries

Provisional entries are now open and will close on Tuesday 21 April. This year, all provisional entries must be submitted via the entry form which has been shared via email.

Please note:

- No invoice will be issued at the time of provisional entries. The full entry fee of \$330 per athlete will be invoiced with definitive entries.
- After provisional entries close, STAs will be notified of the number of competing reserve/additional athletes permitted for 2026, where applicable.
- To assist with this process, please ensure all relevant reserve athletes are listed in your provisional entry submission.

Definitive entries will be submitted via an excel spreadsheet. This will be shared with the STA's in the coming weeks.

Podium Training

Men's Artistic Gymnastics

Women's Artistic Gymnastics

Date: Tuesday 30 June

Levels: Developing International & Senior International

Future International will only be offered podium training if time and scheduling allows - this will be confirmed and communicated once final entries have been submitted

Rhythmic Gymnastics

Date: Tuesday 15 July

Levels: Junior International & Senior International (Individual & Group)

Trampoline Gymnastics

Date: Thursday 9 July

Levels: International Divisions

Acrobatic Gymnastics

Date: Tuesday 15 July

Levels: International Divisions

Aerobic Gymnastics

Date: Saturday 18 July - Morning

Levels: International Divisions

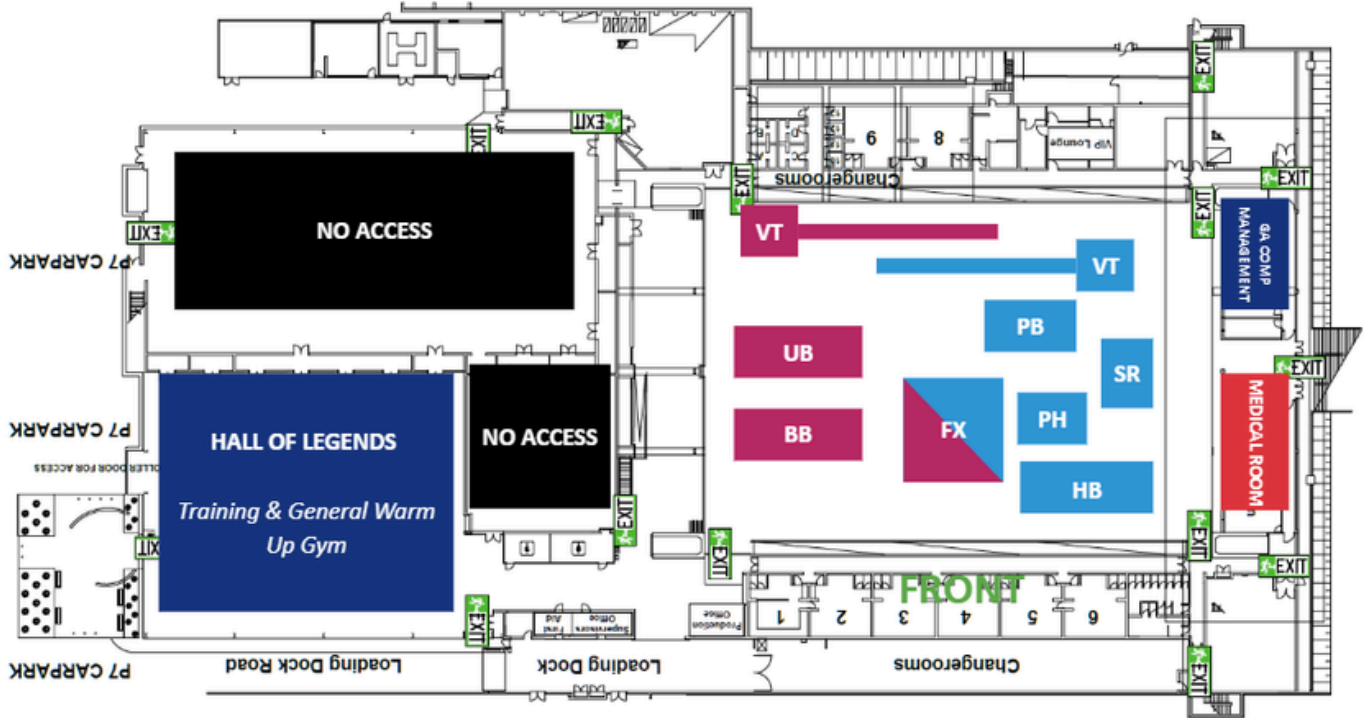
Podium training times for all Gymsports and levels will be confirmed once final entries have been received.

Athletes must wear state team attire for all podium training sessions.

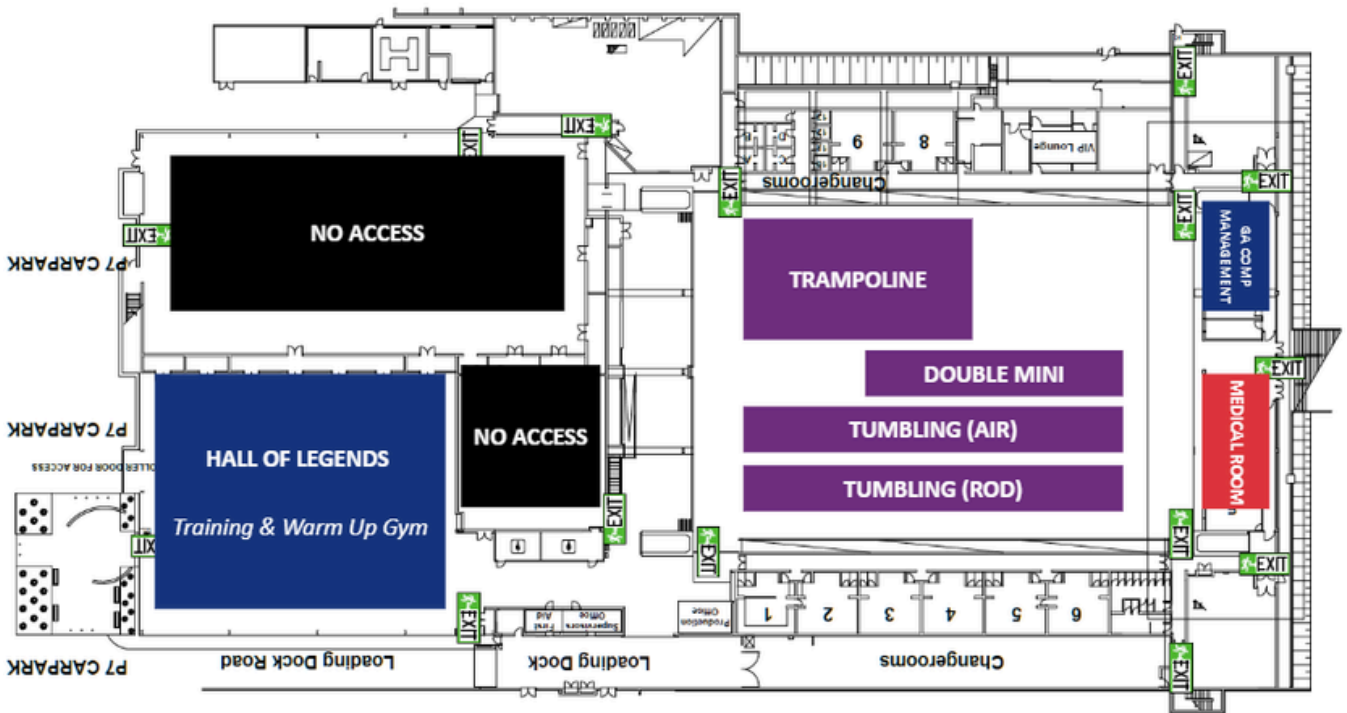


Competition Floor Plans

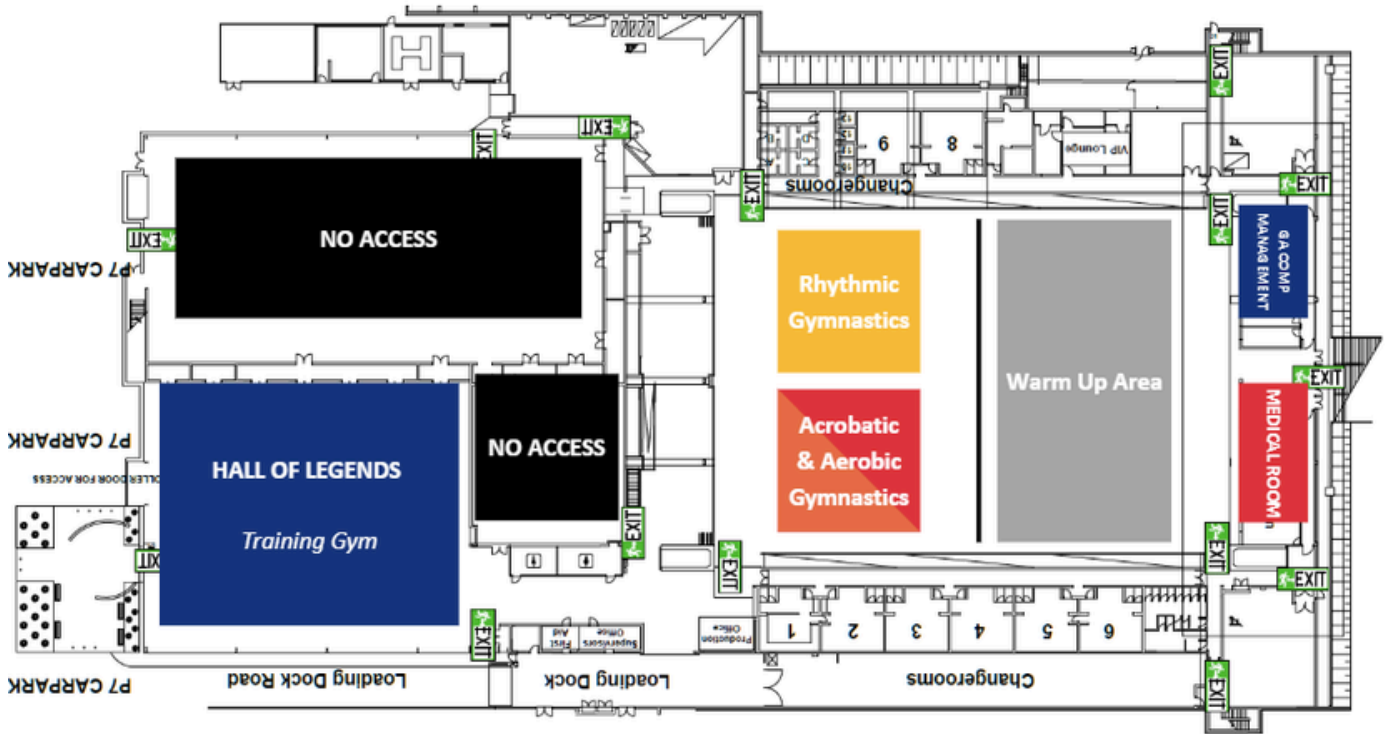


Trampoline Gymnastics

Artistic Gymnastics

Training Hall

The training hall for both Men's and Women's Artistic will be located in the Hall of Legends.

The space is smaller than what we have previously had at the Gold Coast Sports and Leisure Centre and as such, equipment and space available will need to be shared.

Each Gymsport will have access to its own equipment, with the exception of the floor, which will be a shared apparatus.

It is important that teams adhere to their allocated training times. Training outside of Gymnastics Australia allocated times will not be permitted.

Competition Warm Up

All general warm up will take place in the training hall which is located close to the Field of Play.

20mins will be allocated for general warm up for each competition session.

Following this, 5mins will be allocated for teams to transition from the training hall to the competition hall ahead of apparatus warm up.

All apparatus warm up times will be outlined in the respective Gymsport competition workplan.

Trampoline Gymnastics

Training & Warm Up Hall

Training hall access will be available for National Team athletes from 8:00am on Tuesday 7 July. There will be no access prior to this time.

Due to space limitations, a full air floor (including full run-up) will not be available in the training/warm-up hall.

The following equipment will be available in the training hall:

- 2 x Trampolines
- 1 x Double Mini Trampoline
- 1 x 26m Air Floor + 4m run up + full landing zone

The Rod Floor will only be available in the competition arena

Please also note that the roof height in the Hall of Legends is 7m, with a number of low beams sitting at this height. As such, the trampoline will be positioned to avoid these beams.

Rhythmic, Aerobics & Acrobatics Gymnastics

All competition warm-up will take place in the main arena, behind the dividing black curtain. No music is to be played through speakers in this space; athletes are encouraged to use headphones.

Dedicated RG training space will be available in the Hall of Legends and will be scheduled by level and State. A training schedule will be published once final participation numbers are confirmed.

Please note that the roof height in the Hall of Legends is 7m at its lowest point, with a number of beams at this height.

Venue Information

Accreditation Collection

Accreditation collection will be located on Level 3, to the left of the spectator entry. Accreditation office hours will be confirmed and communicated closer to the event.

As in previous years, STAs will be provided with accreditations for competing athletes. All event officials (including coaches, judges, medical personnel and team managers) are required to collect their accreditation individually from the Accreditation Office.

Venue Access

Spectator entry to the venue is via Level 3.

All accredited personnel (once accreditation has been collected) may access the venue for training and competition via Level 2 and then proceed down to Level 1 where the training and competition areas are located.

Accredited personnel wishing to spectate should enter via Level 3.

Judge Attire

Judges attire must be in accordance with the relevant Gymsport Technical Regulations and the World Gymnastics Code of Points.

Please note that due to venue restrictions, stilettos must not be worn under any circumstances.

Meetings

Orientation Meeting

The orientation meeting for all Gymsports will be held virtually via Teams prior to the event.

All Heads of Delegation, Team Managers & Head Coaches should attend the meeting.

Additional details will be available in the coming weeks.

Judges Meetings

In 2026, it is compulsory for all judges attending AGC to attend the scheduled judges' meetings.

Judges that do not attend the meetings will not be included in the final judges' panels for the event.

Please ensure this is communicated to your judges so travel details can be booked accordingly.

Judges' meeting dates and times will be confirmed following the publication of the competition schedule.
