# Event Rules and Regulations

The 2026 Australian Gymnastics Championships will be conducted under the 2026 Technical Regulations and World Gymnastics Code of Points 2025 - 2028 for the respective Gymsports.

These documents are currently available on the Gymnastics Australia website and World Gymnastics website respectively.

## Definitive Entries & Music Submission

Definitive entries are now open and will close on Tuesday 26 May (MAG, WAG & TRP) and Tuesday 2 June (RG, AER, ACR). This year, all definitive entries must be submitted via the entry form which has been shared via email. This form must include all individuals who will be attending the event as part of your state team.

Music for the relevant gymsports is also due at the time of definitive entries. Dropbox folders have been set up and shared. Please ensure that all music is labelled as per the guidelines in the dropbox folders and is submitted by the due date.

### Entry Fee

\$330 inc GST per athlete, per Gymsport

Any fees due payable to Gymnastics Australia will be issued to you via an invoice from a third-party platform. This may attract additional fees associated with the payment method chosen. # Artistic Gymnastics

## Training Hall

The training hall for both Men's and Women's Artistic will be located in the Hall of Legends.

The space is smaller than what we have previously had at the Gold Coast Sports and Leisure Centre and as such, equipment and space available will need to be shared.

Each Gymsport will have access to its own equipment, with the exception of the floor, which will be a shared apparatus.

It is important that teams adhere to their allocated training times. Training outside of Gymnastics Australia allocated times will not be permitted.

A training schedule is currently being developed and will be shared once available.

## Competition Warm Up

All general warm up will take place in the training hall which is located close to the Field of Play.

20mins will be allocated for general warm up for each competition session.

Following this, 5mins will be allocated for teams to transition from the training hall to the competition hall ahead of apparatus warm up.

All apparatus warm up times will be outlined in the respective Gymsport competition workplan.

# Trampoline Gymnastics

## Training & Warm Up Hall

Training hall access will be available for National Team athletes from 8:00am on Tuesday 7 July. There will be no access prior to this time.

Due to space limitations, a full air floor (including full run-up) will not be available in the training/warm-up hall.

The following equipment will be available in the training hall:

- 2 x Trampolines
- 1 x Double Mini Trampoline
- 1 x 26m Air Floor + 4m run up + full landing zone

*The Rod Floor will only be available in the competition arena*

Please also note that the roof height in the Hall of Legends is 7m, with a number of low beams sitting at this height. As such, the trampoline will be positioned to avoid these beams.

# Rhythmic, Aerobics & Acrobatics Gymnastics

All competition warm-up will take place in the main arena, behind the dividing black curtain. No music is to be played through speakers in this space; athletes are encouraged to use headphones.

Dedicated RG training space will be available in the Hall of Legends and will be scheduled by level and State. A training schedule will be published once final participation numbers are confirmed.

Please note that the roof height in the Hall of Legends is 7m at its lowest point, with a number of beams at this height.

To get the full features of this app please go to the App Store or Google Play and download Stack Team App onto your mobile device, then follow these simple steps:

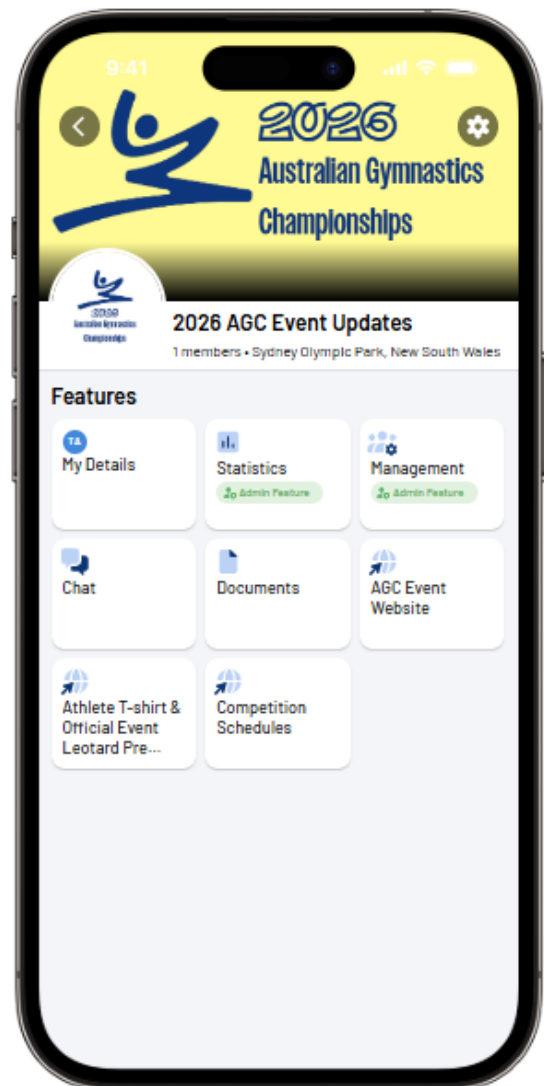
- Sign-up to Stack Team App. You'll be sent an e-mail to activate your account
- Log-in and search for 2026 AGC Event Updates, then request to become a member

When requesting access, please ensure that you enter your full name, state and position on your state team (eg coach & judge). Unknown individuals will not be accepted into groups.

These are closed groups and individuals who are not members of their state team will not be granted access.

Access will be provided following the close of definitive entries once individuals can be verified.

There is no payment required to access the app. Please ensure that your team members stay vigilant and do not provide any payment details at any point.



# Athlete Withdrawals & Refunds

Refund applications must be submitted by each State/Territory Association and will be processed in line with the Event Refund Policy.

Refunds will be paid directly to the relevant STA, and the refund form will be provided to all STAs following the conclusion of the event. To be eligible for a refund, a valid medical certificate must be submitted. In accordance with the policy, the refundable amount will be the entry fee minus a 20% administration fee.

Integrity education equips everyone in sport to recognise risk, make ethical decisions, and help protect the integrity and wellbeing of the gymnastics community.

As with previous years, all attendees at the Australian Gymnastics Championships will be required to complete a series of online education courses prior to collecting their accreditation.
